<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain grey skirt/grey or black trousers • White shirt and tie • Navy blue 'V' neck jumper or cardigan (with logo) • Plain grey socks or grey tights • Polishable, flat black shoes (NOT trainers and no logos) 	<p>The same as Standard OR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White polo shirt • Blue gingham dress • Dark grey/black trousers or shorts • Navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt (with logo) • Plain grey or white socks • Polishable,flat black shoes (NOT trainers & no logos)

COVID REPORTING OVER THE EASTER HOLIDAYS

We have been informed by the Worcestershire Public Health team that we are to continue with our Covid reporting track and trace system over the Easter period for any children who develop symptoms within 48 hours of having been in school. Therefore, if your child is in school on Thursday 1st April and develops symptoms at any point up to and including Saturday 3rd April, no matter when the test is taken, you must inform the school using the email address

covid@coppice.worcs.sch.uk.

This is the only email address which will be regularly monitored over the Easter period.

Please act as quickly as possible to get a test if your child does develop symptoms so we can raise the alert to other parents if necessary. Thank you all for your understanding and assistance with this.

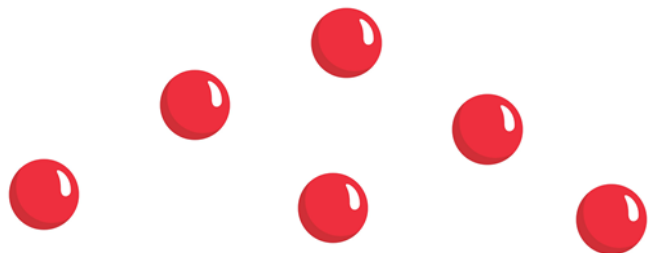
