Further important staffing information for the academic year 21-22:

Mr. Laight will remain as Assistant Head within the Senior Leadership Team comprising also of Mr. Hutt (Headteacher), Mrs. Ashwell (Deputy Head) and Mrs. Webster (School Business Manager). However, he will now have a non-classed based role but will still be teaching English to a group of Year 6 pupils every day. He will also be taking the lead on coaching our Early Career Teachers, as well as working with other teachers throughout the school, supporting the development of their English teaching.

Miss. Juneman (Years 2, 4, 5 and 6), Mrs. Robinson (Years 4, 5 and 6), Miss. Townsend (Years 1, 2 and 3), Miss. Gough (Nursery and Reception), Mr. Edwards (Physical Education) and Mrs. Williams (Spanish) will be providing statutory 'Planning, Preparation and Assessment' (PPA) release time for teachers as well as other release for class-based leaders in school.

Mrs. Heptinstall will be our Senior SENDCO with primary responsibility for Early Years and Key Stage One. I have also made the decision to also employ Mr. McGarry as an additional non-class based SENDCO with primary responsibility for Key Stage 2. Mr. McGarry has proved over a number of years that he will be excellent in this role. He will also be completing the Statutory SENDCO qualification at Birmingham University one day a week. We wanted to increase capacity in this vital area of school and are very pleased with the decision that we have made. Mrs. Heptinstall will work three days a week and Mr. McGarry will work five.

Staff leaving us:

Miss. Gieron (Year 5 Teacher), Mr. Lee (Reception Teacher), Mrs. Sealey (Year 3 Teacher and Miss. Smith (Year 4 Teaching Assistant) will all be leaving us at the end of the year. We want to thank them for all the time that they have put into the The Coppice Primary School and the service that they have given to the children. We wish them all well for the future.

Staff joining us:

Joining us in September will be Mrs. Bellamy (Year 1 Teacher), Miss. Whitehouse (Year 5 Teacher), Mrs. Witham (Year 4 Teaching Assistant), Mrs. Thompson (Year 3 Teaching Assistant), Mrs. Witcomb (Special Support Assistant) and Miss. Jones (Special Support Assistant). We know that you will all welcome these new members of staff into The Coppice family.

Staff getting married:

Two of our members of staff are getting married and will return with different surnames in September. Miss Harris will become Mrs. Russell and Miss. Jones will become Mrs. Davenall. We wish them both all the very best for their big days and of course for their future married lives.
