Safer Internet Day

Next Tuesday, 11th February is Safer Internet Day, where events around the globe are hosted to remind young people how to stay safe online. We have invited PC Simon Gallagher from West Mercia Police to deliver a short presentation to all our children from Year 1 to Year 6. Our Nursery and Reception children will have a class activity to complete on that day. Smart rules

5 Safe- Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information when you're chatting and posting online. Personal information includes your email address, telephone number and password.

Meet- Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parent's or carer's permission and even then only when they can be present. Remember online friends are still strangers even if you have been talking to them for a long time.

A Accepting- Accepting emails, messages or opening files, images or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages!

R Reliable- Someone online might lie about who they are and information on the internet may not be true. Always check information by telling an adult if you are not sure (see below).

Tell- Tell a parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone, or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.
