# Important information regarding changes to your child's spelling homework

**Head Teacher's News** 

At The Coppice we are constantly evaluating how children learn and how best we can ensure that the skills and knowledge they are taught are committed to their long-term memories.

As with many other schools, children acquiring key spelling rules and patterns is an important area of focus for us in terms of school development, especially due to the high level of spelling demand within the current National Curriculum across all year groups.

At present, children in Years 2-6 have daily Read, Write, Inc spelling or phonic teaching delivered by their Class Teacher where spelling rules are taught and where the children can practise the rule through a series of different activities. As you will all know from your child's homework, this class teaching and practise is then supplemented through on-line practise using "Spellodrome".

However, in order to ensure that the children secure their knowledge of the taught spelling rules, patterns and other key words even more comprehensively, we are also going to be asking your child every week to practise learning six key spellings at home using what is known as the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' method. This a proven strategy for helping children to learn spellings and will complement greatly what we already do.

The children will be expected to practise these six spellings daily over the course of the week and they will then be tested on them. Not only will this enable your child to test themselves but it will also enable us to further assess how well they are progressing in terms of their learning of spelling.

In order that your child can record their practise in a systematic way, next Monday (14<sup>th</sup> January 2019) all children from Years 2-6 will receive a new 'Homework Log'. Within the log there will now be a 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' section where the practise can be completed.

Please help your child to use this strategy by getting them to: Look at the new spelling carefully

-Say it

-Cover it over with a piece of paper or their hand -Write the spelling again next to the word

-Uncover the spelling to check if they have got it right

The current 'Spellodrome' homework expectations will not change as the new expectation will run alongside it.

As this is an extremely important homework activity, any child who does not fulfil this new expectation at home will be expected to complete it at school in their own time.

If you have any questions about the new spelling homework expectations, please speak to your child's Class Teacher.

Once again, thank you for your support with your child's learning.
