Concerns and complaints

We are very lucky at The Coppice that we have a caring, dedicated staff who work hard in the best interests of the children. Accordingly, concerns and complaints from parents are comparatively rare. Also, we work hard at keeping relationships with parents strong. However, from time to time we are approached by parents who want to voice a concern or complaint.

Regarding this, we have a strict order of referral:

In the first instance, it is always the class teacher who you need to see. This can be done at handover, at the end of the day. Or, if a more substantial meeting is required, you can book a time with the teacher then or via the school office either in person or by phone.

Depending on the nature of the concern or complaint, the class teacher may involve the Year Group Leader. However, if you feel that the matter has still not been resolved you can request to meet the Year Group Leader yourself. Occasionally, some parents have a determination to go 'straight to the top', to coin a phrase. This is only appropriate where the concern or complaint is of such magnitude that it merits by-passing the procedures described above (e.g. if a child is on the verge of exclusion or there has been some gross professional misconduct).

Now we are full three form entry in every year group, being a large school, we have to have 'distributed leadership/management' in the way described above. If all concerns came straight to Mr Hutt or myself, we would be inundated.
