### SCHOOL LUNCHES

Chef Matt has made some alterations to the School lunch menu so that KS2 children will have options for hot food on a few days each week (but not every day).

When you now look on Parent Pay to select your child's meal you will see options with the prefix "**Packed Lunch of**" which is either hot or cold food depending on the day. These are available to Years 3, 4, 5 and 6.

The prefix of "**Hot Dinner of**" is only available to Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2 and means tested Free School Meal children only.

If your Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 or free school meals child wants a hot meal please order from "hot dinner of" rather than selecting the hot food item in the "packed lunch of" section.
