

# The Coppice Whole School Newsletter Friday 16th September 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you have all had a good week and are looking forward to the weekend with your children. It has been really lovely this week to welcome so many of you in person to our Parent Information sessions that were held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. I sincerely hope that the information that you have received has been very useful and informative as this is what we want it to be. Should anything remain unclear though, please don't hesitate to contact your child's Class Teacher.

We do appreciate that not all of you were able to attend these meetings. However, it is vital to us that you still receive the information that was shared. Therefore, in order to help everyone to either access the information again, or to receive it for the first time, we have uploaded the Year Group presentations into the Year group newsletters area on the school website.

#### Visit to Woodrush:

This week, I went To Woodrush High School for my first visit of the year and to meet with the Headteacher: Mr. Barber. As well as talking about school developments and joint initiatives moving forward, I also had the privilege of having a tour of parts of the school. This included spending time on the playground at breaktime and in Year 7 science lessons. I was bowled over by the amount of ex-Coppice pupils from Year 7 though to Year 11 who came to say hello and shake my hand. They were very pleased to see me (thankfully) and to engage in conversation. It gave me a really great feeling to see what polite, lovely young people they are continuing to grow into. I was also really impressed with the calm, friendly atmosphere on the playground and I know Mr. Barber and his staff work very hard to ensure that this is the case. As I've said before, our on-going, close links with Woodrush are incredibly important to both Mr. Barber and me in ensuring that our children transition extremely well when they eventually leave us and also so that they continue to progress to the full academically.

#### Swimming pool and lessons:

Thank you to all parents and carers who have approached both Mrs. Ashwell and me to give such positive feedback on the swimming pool that we have had installed on site and the fact that we are now able to provide swimming lessons to all of the children from Years 3-6. Children learning to swim is something that we feel passionate about as it is a key, life skill that enables our children to be as safe as possible in water. Some of the stories in the press over the summer, where children have come to harm because they couldn't swim, further illustrates why we see this as so important. Swimming is a statutory part of the curriculum and, unfortunately, we were not able to take all children swimming offsite during the Covid period e.g. our current Year 6 pupils. We therefore thought creatively about how we could give an opportunity for all children to still have swimming lessons and this is how we decided to do it. It is also much better to have a pool on site rather than spend a lot of time on a coach for only a short lesson. Costs of coaches are also not getting any cheaper! Moving forward, we would like to be able to do a similar thing either every year or at least every two years so please be reassured that we will continue to place learning to swim as a vital part of our PE curriculum and ethos.





### Quad developments:

I mentioned to you all before the holiday that we would be having a lot of work done on our quad area over the course of the summer break in order to create a sensory garden and outside extension to our library area. As you will see from the pictures below, this involved removing the old, worn paving and garden area and replacing it with astro-turf, planters, seating, bean bags and water features. We are absolutely thrilled with how this space looks and feels and I know that all of the children from Nursery through to Year 6 will greatly enjoy experiencing it over the course of the year. Our Thrive provision will also be greatly enhanced by this multi-use, calm space. The work isn't quite finished and there will be a few further additions moving forward.





#### Well done Beau!

I just want to say a huge well done to Beau from Year 4 who, over the summer break, took part in the Les Miserables UK tour at Birmingham Hippodrome. She played Little Cosette and sang on the stage in front of lots of people. She had auditioned for the part before gaining the role and had both surprised and impressed her family with her confidence. Having congratulated Beau personally and having spoken to her about this fantastic achievement, she is rightly very proud of herself as are her family. Beau hopes to continue doing more shows in the future and, as a school, we greatly look forward to hearing about her progress. It sounds very much like she could well follow in the footsteps of one of our former pupils: Glen Facey who has performed in a number of West End shows including Mary Poppins and is currently performing in Back to the Future. #### About our Course

- Children will be fully supervised at all times, although parents are welcome to stay and watch.
  Each child will be provided with a football for individual practice and their progress will be recorded each week.
