As I said in last week's newsletter, The Coppice gymnasts represented the West Midlands region at the British schools' national finals last weekend, along with Woodrush High School, Peterbrook Primary School & Woodview School. Schools, from all over the country, competed against each other at both Under 11s and U16s. This was a big stage to perform on as the nationals are always a very tough competition and the calibre of gymnastics is extremely high. Nevertheless, all schools did amazingly well and, as always, we were incredibly proud of how our children performed and conducted themselves.

In what was a superb achievement, The Coppice boys' Under 11's team came 3rd overall in the national competition and also came 2nd overall in the West Midlands region.

Then, the West Midlands combined scores across all groups in the Under 11's section meant we came 3rd overall which was a fabulous surprise and all gymnasts came away with a medal.

Former Coppice pupils: Grace, Jack and Holly are now the Under 13 mixed Milano National Champions! This was an incredible achievement by the trio, who won many gymnastic titles when representing The Coppice. We are so proud of all three of these children and I know that their achievement will prove to be incredibly inspirational to the current Coppice gymnasts moving forward.



Robotics Workshops for Years 2 and 6:

On 7th and 14th March our Year 2 and 6 pupils experienced two wonderful Robotics days where they entered into a whole variety of computer coding challenges. The children loved every moment, were fully engaged throughout and rose to all of the challenges and problems they faced. There was so much learning and so many great experiences. Anthony, from Hyett Education, who delivered the workshops, had nothing but praise for both year groups. I felt extremely proud, as Headteacher, when I observed bits of each of the sessions and saw just how much our children were getting from them.

It was also really interesting to talk to Anthony about how coding will more and more be the future in so many different careers as the years go on. Technology and robotics are advancing all of the time and therefore, these experiences enable our children to see and get a feel for what many of them may well be doing as a career. Obviously, it was lovely to also receive an email off Anthony where he wrote:

'Just wanted to email to say thank you for inviting us back to your school last week and today. The children have been wonderful and hopefully we've provided a positive educational experience for them.' You certainly did Anthony!

Star of the Week - Hot Chocolate






We had two hot chocolate with the Head sessions this week due to missing last Friday due to the snow.

Reminder - Science Fair entries.

The entries for the Science Fair Competition are due in on Monday 20th March

The project can be an age appropriate experiment to answer a question or a problem, along with a solution, or it could be a research project. It can be <u>on any area of science that interests your child</u>, for example 'How many stars can we see?', 'How does a hovercraft work?' or 'What would life be like if I spent a month in the international space station?', 'What happens when I mix....and...... or researching a significant scientist who has made a difference to our everyday lives.



When your child has carried out their investigation or research they have to make a display board to communicate their learning to others. This can be made from a large cardboard box opened out and then painted or covered in wrapping paper and held together with tape. It needs to have three panels of information (as shown). This display board should show the project title/question/problem, what your child thinks the answer is, what they did to investigate their question, what they found and a conclusion. If they wish, they may also include a small model, experiment and/or project. They must have names / class / year group clearly visible.

All projects need to be in school by Monday 20th March and our School Science Fair will take place during the week of 27th March. A panel of judges will help to choose the best projects.
