Thank you to all parents who support our uniform policy by ensuring children have an appropriate PE kit available for days they have PE. However, we have noticed some children wearing non-uniform sportswear.

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PE is part of our school uniform and, as such, it is mandatory (supported by the DfE).

The expectations around our school PE kit, taken from our website, are set out below.

PE Kit: White t- shirt, navy or black shorts, pumps or low sided trainers in a pump bag.

For outdoor PE (or 'Games' lessons) children can wear plain blue or black tracksuits over their regular PE kit (i.e. over t-shirts).

These items are very affordable and can be bought very cheaply from supermarkets and high street stores. An added advantage is that it negates the pressure some children feel to wear expensive branded items that can create issues in school.
