Dear Parents and Carers.

Firstly, I would like to start by giving you all an update on Mr.Heptinstall. Mr. Heptinstall has already popped in a couple of times over the last two weeks and it has been fantastic to see him in school again with a smile on his face. He has once again thanked you all for the many 'get well soon' messages that he has received

Obviously, this final half-term of the year marks the last one that Mr.Heptinstall will be Headteacher at The Coppice before retiring. His retirement will be marked in school with a leaving event for staff on the very last day of term, Covid restriction allowing. The children have also been busy making cards and writing farewell messages. A few parents have asked me in the last couple of days whether there is a collection that they can contribute to and the answer to this question is yes. We have set up a payment item in your Parent Pay entitled Mr Heptinstall's retirement contribution that you can use in order to do this. Please be reassured though that there is no expectation to contribute.

A couple of parents have mentioned being unaware of the uniform expectations for September. Can I therefore remind you all to look at and read closely the 'Uniform Special' newsletter that I put out to all parents on the Friday before the half-term holiday, as there are a couple of important changes for you to note. I stress again though that the expectations that I have communicated are designed to be both achievable and affordable and will ensure a uniform standard for all children that gives a clear statement about what we stand for as a school and the pride we have at belonging to The Coppice. Therefore, please ensure that your child meets the required expectations as they are non-negotiable. Thank you to those parents who have already commented so positively in response to what was communicated.

Last week's newsletter also reminded parents and carers of how they can access both the whole-school and year group newsletters that are so vital for you to read in order that you are fully informed about key information regarding the school as a whole or your child. Again, if you didn't read this newsletter, then please do so. We don't want any parent to not be informed of what is going on in school.

Finally, please be reassured that over the coming weeks, I will be communicating to you all about who your child's next teacher will be as I know that you will all be keen to know this. There are just a couple of things to still sort out with regards to staffing and I will then be in a position to communicate the whole school picture. Therefore, please be patient until then.
