

The cut off date for Year 6 applications to High School is 31st October. Please note that this date falls within half term. You will not be able to contact the school office about this due to total closure for deep cleaning.

We have had the following information sent to us by Worcester School Admissions.

"The importance of making an application on time cannot be stressed enough. A late application can only be considered **after** all those received on time. This places those children at a disadvantage. In areas where place availability is more limited some of the most vulnerable families, applying late, cannot be accommodated in their local schools, and in some cases, have not been able to attend the same school as their siblings".
