Coming up at The Coppice

We break up for one week for half term today (25th October) and we look forward to seeing the children back in school on Monday 4th November.

Please note that this day is a TED day for Woodrush but NOT for The Coppice and children are expected in as usual.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PROVISONAL TED DAY DATE SET AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR HAS HAD TO CHANGE. THE NEW DATE IS MONDAY 1ST JUNE 2020.

When the children return they should be in standard/winter uniform. To clarify...

Reception, Year 1, Year 2

STANDARD (from September to July)

- Plain grey skirt/grey or black trousers or grey pinafore
 - White polo shirt
 - Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with logo)
 - Plain grey socks or grey tights
- Polishable, flat black shoes (NOT trainers and no logos)

Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

STANDARD (from September to July)

- Plain grey skirt/grey or black trousers
 - White shirt and tie
- Navy blue 'V' neck jumper or cardigan (with logo)
 - Plain grey socks or grey tights
- Polishable, flat black shoes (NOT trainers and no logos)

PE Kit: White T shirt, navy or black shorts, pumps or low sided trainers in a pump bag. If children bring in tracksuits for outdoor PE they should be navy or black. Crop tops and gym gear are not permitted for PE lessons. **All parts of uniform must be named.**

NOT ALLOWED: Nail varnish, make-up or jewellery (with the exception of small, plain stud earrings). Boots are not part of school uniform. If boots are worn to school during the Winter, children must bring their school shoes to change into. Trainers are not acceptable for everyday wear in school.

We expect children to be smartly presented, avoiding fashion accessories and hairstyles e.g. hair colouring, Mohican hairstyle etc. Hairbands are permitted (white, black or blue only). All of the above uniform (with logo), together with showerproof, reversible jackets (with logo) are available from: Clive Mark Schoolwear (Poplar Road, Kings Heath) and Early Years (Stratford Road, Shirley).

The school office sell both elasticated and "tie it yourself" ties which are available for £6 (the same price as Early Years Uniform shop). School book bags (£5), backpacks (£8), water bottles (£1.50) and bottle lids (50p) are also available from the school office.
