#### Safety on our playground / premises

A timely reminder about one or two things.

We do not allow scooters and bicycles to be ridden on our premises. It's not that we want to be 'kill joys' but it is easy for these things to proliferate, and, before we know it, we have a playground full of children racing around on scooters and bicycles. In the past, we have had one or two nasty accidents and 'near misses' with these.

In addition, dogs are not allowed on our premises. Our premises extend to the fence-line, at the outer edge of the car park, in Shawhurst Lane. Accordingly, dogs should not be brought beyond this point.

Most parents are very good at taking responsibility for their children whilst on our site. However, we have had some issues with younger children in particular, racing up and down the steps and ramp near to the two adjacent Year 4 classrooms. Again, there have been nasty accidents there over the years and some 'near misses'.

Children have also been playing in amongst the shrubs in the planted areas at the front of school, which is causing damage to the plants. If you are waiting in or around the staff car park please do not allow you children to play here or in the very dangerous car park. Children are running in and out of and hiding behind vehicles. Please use the path rather than walking through the car park. Accordingly, please can all parents be mindful of this and take responsibility for their children whilst on site (which, I know, a lot of parents do).
