Our learning this week

In English this week, we have completed our learning around the Little Red Riding Hood story. The children planned their own traditional tale, based on the original, and then wrote this story, focusing carefully upon non-negotiables along with adverb openers, conjunctions and adjectives. In Maths, we have completed mini assessments on our recent learning on multiplication and division and have also recapped some money work whereby the children had to use coins in different ways to make a given amount. Finally, we recapped some of the shape learning we completed during our home learning.

Phonics/Reading

Please continue to read with your child over the Easter holiday. Some children are not completing very much reading outside of school and this can hamper their overall progress.

Homework

We will not be setting any My Maths or Spelling Shed assignments over the Easter holidays. However, your child can still access Spelling Shed to practise some of the word lists. We would also recommend children practise their 2, 5 and 10 times tables and Hit the Button (an online game) is always a popular way of improving speed in class!
