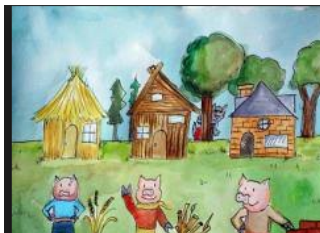


Coppice Year 1 Newsletter

This week we are learning:
