## English:

We will be adding the suffix -ed to write a re-count on 'How to plant a Turnip'. We will also be focusing on using the correct language to sequence sentences in the correct order.



**Maths:** We will be exploring the concept of volume and capacity using containers. Children will be comparing the volume by describing whether it is full, nearly full, empty or nearly empty. We will also be measuring the capacity of different containers using a small plastic cup as a non-standard unit of measure.

**Topic:** The children will begin to design and make their own clay plant pot against the design criteria using a repeated pattern. Once the pots have dried and the children have painted them we will be selling them!

## Year 1 Plant Pot Enterprise:

We will be busy making and designing clay plant pots during our Topic lessons. The children will be selling these to raise money to buy resources for Year 1. The plant pots will contain a bean plant that the children have been personally growing at school. They will be 'For Sale' outside your child's classroom Thursday 11th and Friday 12th April straight after school. They will be sold at a great price of £2! Thanks in advance for your support.

## W.O.W word of the week:

We will be sharing new vocabulary with the children that will support our learning in class. Can you use the word at home? We have sent home a template for you to share and display the word at home together.

'capacity' - the maximum amount something can contain.

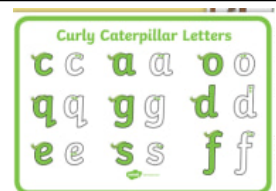

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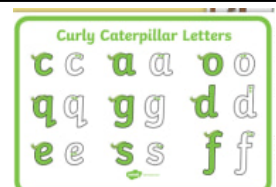
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
