Our learning this week

In Maths, we have moved on from addition and subtraction and have started to explore money. The children have been identifying the coins and notes we have in the UK and have looked at exchanging money of the same value, for example, five 2p coins for one 10p coin. If you have any loose change, you could ask your child to practise their money skills at home, which would help them to become more confident. In English, the children have practised their instruction writing skills by completing a shared write before writing their own set of instructions (independently) for how to build a snowman.
