## Our learning this week

This week in English, we have continued our work around 'The Disgusting Sandwich' story. The children have been learning to write different types of sentences, using correct punctuation for questions, exclamatory sentences, commands and statements. We have also completed our class shared write diary entry. In Maths, we've been learning about fractions! This week, we have been learning how to find one quarter of a shape and number. The children have practised their sharing method and have taken care with their presentation to help them when counting.

There will be no PE for any class so children do not need to wear or bring in their PE kit. Weather permitting, the photos will be taken outside.

Reading is without doubt, the most important skill we can teach the children as it allows them to access all other areas of the curriculum. This is vital in order for your child to be able to build on existing skills whilst providing a good opportunity for lots of reading for pleasure – promoting a love of reading.

Each Friday, new assignments will be set for children to consolidate the maths/spelling/phonics learning the children have completed in school that week. Children have until the following Friday to complete these assignments so please encourage your child as this will support their learning.
