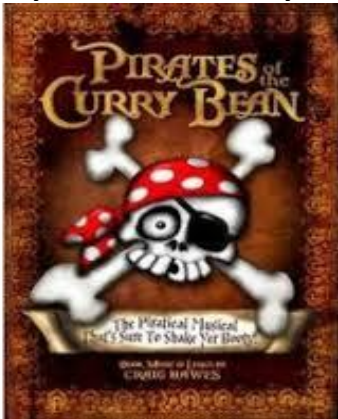
Coming up at The Coppice
