Head Teacher's News

Snow Closure (at the risk of tempting fate)

It is always very difficult making the decision to close the school. It is the one part of my job as headteacher that I hate. Accordingly, I ask for your understanding when this has to happen; the decision is never made lightly. Whenever possible, The Coppice Primary School will remain open. We have had a good track record in recent years of trying our best to stay open when other local schools have closed.

However, we have to consider the safety of all children, parents and staff;,some of whom travel quite a distance to school each day. Should the need arise, in severe weather, a decision will be made by 7.30 am at the latest if the school is to be closed.

A text message* alert will be sent informing you of school closure as well as a prominent notice of closure on our school website. I will also ring radio Heart FM (100.7 FM) snowline and Free radio (96.4 FM) snowline and ask them to broadcast the relevant information. A notification will also be posted on our official school Facebook page (The Coppice Primary School, Hollywood). This is probably most reliable as it should not crash.

In addition, do check for a text message or check the website if heavy snow is forecast (but not arrived).

If heavy snow starts falling during the school day then we may make the decision to close and contact parents via text and the website to ask them to collect children early whilst roads are still accessible.

It is best not to be too reliant on our texting service and website as the sites may crash under heavy traffic and please try not to phone the school for closure information, as phone lines can be easily blocked.

I reiterate, our aim is to open every day but hopefully this information will give some clarity.

Important - Lunches next week

Friday 16th December all years. A full hot meal will be provided as usual (as per the online menu) and party food will be supplementary to the lunch and not instead of a hot meal.
