Update on 30 hours nursery funding

In April there will be a national TV and press campaign explaining about the 30 hours nursery funding. Until then, we have some information:

Parents will apply directly to HMRC and, if they are eligible, will be issued with a voucher code to give to school – this needs to be done every three months.

Eligibility criteria - both parents are working (or sole parent in a lone parent family) and each parent/carer earns between, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage and less than £100,000 per year.

Next week, we will be writing to everyone who has applied to nursery to ask their preference for hours, which we will aim to accommodate in September 2017.

Application forms for nursery are available from the school office - the closing date is Monday 27th February 2017 and places will be allocated at the end of March.

Scooters - health and safety

We have had a number of incidents over the years where accidents have caused injury due to scooter use on our playground. Because of this, we have had a ban on using scooters on site for some years now.

On the face of it, it might seem that it is a killjoy attitude to ban scooter use whilst on school premises but the problem is, if we allow one child to use their scooter then the next day there will be more children using scooters, and the next day more still, until we have a difficult situation from a health and safety point of view.

Accordingly, given the above, I have to remind parents that we have a total ban on the use of scooters, bicycles, skateboards and the like once children are inside the school gates. Mr Mace has placed warning notices around school reminding everyone of this.

Please do help us by ensuring that your child is not breaking this rule. We thank you in anticipation of your understanding with this.
