### **Head Teacher's News**

#### **Attendance Rewards**

On Tuesday, 91 children were presented with a bronze '100% attendance star' for achieving 100% attendance in the Spring Term. This follows on from the 185 children who achieved a bronze star in the Autumn Term. 100 of these 185 children were also presented with their silver '100% attendance star' for having achieved 100% attendance in both the Autumn and Spring Terms. This means that of all the children from Reception through to Year 6 in school, 276 have now achieved a bronze or silver 100% star, representing a fantastic achievement for which these children (and their parents) can feel rightly proud!

Just to remind you, the stars can be worn on either sweatshirts, ties or summer uniform with the children free to choose which option they prefer. Infants can wear them on sweatshirts or summer uniform. Both stars can be worn at the same time if the children would like to.

Unfortunately, due to the cost of the badges, we won't be able to replace them for free if they are lost so please encourage your child to look after them. Replacements can be bought from the school office for £1.00.

If your child hasn't achieved a badge yet or just narrowly missed out, they can still earn their bronze badge if they attend for every day of this term. For those children who achieved a bronze star this time, they will now have the opportunity to go for their silver star, and for those children who achieved a silver star, they will have the opportunity to go for their whole year 100% attendance badge. This means that every child still has something to aim for!

Remember too that any child with 98% attendance for the whole of this academic year (up to the cut-off point in the Summer Term) will receive the attendance treat in the last week of the academic year.

We do appreciate that sometimes appointments or illness get in the way of achieving 100% for the year which is why we moved to the termly stars reward, meaning that there are plenty of opportunities to be rewarded for attendance in every term.
