Our learning this week

In Maths, the children have continued with our addition and subtraction topic. They have progressed on to more complex numbers and after solving the calculations by using practical resources (dienes), they were then able to continue on to solving questions using a written method. In English, we have completed our work around the Lost and Found story with the children developing their own version of the story. They had to concentrate really hard so they could include all of the grammar skills we've been learning throughout this term such as conjunctions, adjectives and expanded noun phrases.
