Our learning this week

In English this week, we have been writing spine poems! Spine poems need to include adjectives, nouns and verbs so we recapped what each of these word types were and practised using them. As a class, we created a spine poem all about tigers before the children planned and wrote their own spine poem about Prince Grogbah, a character from our class book, 'The Nothing to See Here Hotel'.

In Maths, we have been recapping the four operations. The children have added and subtracted two 2-digit numbers, drawing dienes to calculate the answers, before practising their multiplication and division skills relating to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
