The Coppice Primary School is proud to be part of The Grove* Partnership of schools which includes: Lickey Hills Primary School, Holywell Primary & Nursery School and Beaconside Primary & Nursery School.

Each school within our local group has something distinctive to share and we can all learn from each other's good practice. We see ourselves as partners not rivals and see collaboration as the future for further school improvement, whilst all retaining our uniqueness and individuality. This partnership has evolved from our work with the Bromsgrove schools network, which includes all first, middle and primary schools in the Bromsgrove district (known as the Bromsgrove Learning Network (BLN)).

Within the network, schools break away into smaller groups like The Grove; for The Coppice that means that we will continue to actively work with all Bromsgrove primary schools as well as BLN.
