Our learning this week

This week in English, we have read the Lost and Found story by Oliver Jeffers, which will form a focus for our writing this half term. The children have written sentences about the characters in the book and we have been learning how to use conjunctions such as but, because and so, to extend our sentences. In Maths, we have been adding a two-digit number to a tens number (such as 34 + 30), using dienes to support the calculations. The children have also recapped their knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes. In our other learning, we have started to look at the history of transport and this is something we will continue to explore over the coming weeks.

Phonics/Reading

We have started to re-assess the children's phonic knowledge this week so you may find their reading book level has altered as a result. Please continue to support your child with reading the e-book (which will recap learning from our whole class lessons) as well as completing at least two reads of their home reading book (which will suit their individual reading level).
