### Our learning this week

This week in English, we have continued our work around The Disgusting Sandwich story where we are writing a diary entry. We have practised using possessive apostrophes, have changed the story to our own class version and we have begun writing this in our own words. In Maths, we have started a new topic on fractions! First, we recapped wholes, equal and unequal groups before investigating what a half is and what a quarter is.
