Here is what we will be learning this week:

Reading

The school has now acquired more bug club phonics books. This enables us to use them during guided reading sessions.

Your child will now read a book, set to their phonic ability, in class and then bring it home on a Monday to read at home. Rereading books is really important because it helps children build confidence and fluency, skills that we are currently working hard on.

Water bottles.

Although the temperature has dropped, it is still important that children bring in water bottles.

Due to covid, the water fountains are all turned off and we can not share cups out with children. Therefore children must bring a named drinks bottle with water in.
