**Homework:**

**Mathematics:** In preparation for the SATs tests the children will now receive paper homework. This week the children have been given an arithmetic paper - they are usually given 30 minutes to complete this test. However, this is practise and can be supported at home.

**Spellodrome:** The children are expected to achieve 500 points weekly. In addition to this, they are now expected to complete the look, say, cover, write and cover tasks in their homework diary. They will be tested on these words each Monday and then given 6 new spellings to learn.

**Reading:** Children should continue to read at least three times per week; parents should denote all reading with a daily signature in your child's homework diary.

**English:** Your child should have brought a picture of our new class WAGOLL home. We have been learning a letter of complaint. Please encourage your child to practise their WAGOLL.

**Topic:** A reminder that optional homework is due for *Bright Sparks*. Please bring in any completed entries after half-term. This is an optional homework; however, homework like this will help prepare the children for secondary school.

**Tudors**

Next half-term the children will learn about the Tudors. This week the children will bring home a new knowledge organiser containing all of the facts that will underpin our learning, as well a list of optional creative homeworks linked to the Tudors.
