In our maths lessons this week we have completed the SATs papers from 2019.

There will be MyMaths activities to consolidate their learning on decimals.

There are three activities which need to be completed this week to revise the learning we have been concentrating on in class.

- Dividing decimals by whole numbers
- Multiply decimals by whole numbers
- Multiplying decimals by 10 and 1000
