Homework:

You will find any logins that your child needs in their green homework log. Your child will have received a new homework diary this week which will need to be completed weekly.

Mymaths:

In our maths lessons we have been completing some work on ratio and proportion. There are three activities which need to be completed this week to consolidate the learning we have been completing in class.

- Modelling ratio
- Ratio introduction
- Proportion introduction

Spelling shed:
