Important Dates and Messages:

- **To encourage independence** and in preparation for Reception, please drop off Nursery children at their classroom doors, after the Easter holidays.
- **We will be continuing with the focus child system after the Easter break, but will focus on one child per key person, to ensure maximum support in preparation for Reception.**
- **Please continue to encourage your children** to wash their hands very well after going to the toilet, when they cough/ sneeze/ blow their nose and when they come in from outdoors. Thank you.
