<u>This week we have been...</u>

- Ordering Numicon plates from one to ten and naming each one. We have used the vocabulary: one more/one less, larger/smaller and fewer. The children have also practiced counting carefully using 1:1 correspondence.
- Creating our own perfumes using a range of scented resources.
- Making robots out of playdough and adding metal parts such as screws, nuts and bolts.
- Tapping out syllables in words using percussion instruments.
