## This week/next week we are learning about.....

- **We want to share with you how incredibly proud we are of the children. They have continued to amaze us daily with how confident, happy and settled they are. They have made an excellent start to Nursery! Well done everyone and thank you for all the support you have given.**
- This week, your child has come home with a key worker letter. This will inform you of who your child's key worker is and the role that they play. Information can be passed on to teachers and TA's at the start and the end of the day. **Please be aware that class teachers have responsibility for the whole class and that all significant information must be shared with teachers.** You may receive comments about progress and suggestions for activities from your child's key worker.
- We will be starting to attend Forest Rangers the week commencing 27th September. We will then attend on Tuesday and Fridays every week this half term. If possible please send your child in wearing a PE kit on forest ranger days. This will be a white t-shirt, navy joggers and navy hoodie. You will also need to bring a navy all in one waterproof suit and wellies to keep in Nursery.
- We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £5 per term to help us buy craft and malleable resources. Please put this in a named envelope and pass this to your child's teacher.
- Please name your child's water bottle. We will be providing a healthy snack daily for the children at school. If your child has any dietary requirements and you have discussed this with your class teacher then please send in a named box or bag with their healthy snack.
- Have a fantastic weekend and we look forward to seeing the children next week.
