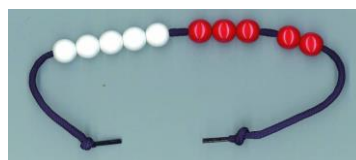
Monday 11th November – Peter Pan performance. Please pay via parentpay.
