Our week ahead – What are we going to be learning?

- 3D shapes: using the mathematical names for 3D shapes (sphere, cylinder, cone, cube, cuboid).
- Describing the properties of 3D shapes and sorting them by their properties.
- Making suggestions about what might be the items inside Santa's sack by looking at the shapes.
- Learning the nativity story.
- The Nativity story, knowing that it is a story from the Bible.
- Sequencing pictures from the Nativity using time related words such as first, next, after that and finally.
- Writing labels, listening to the sounds and practising our letter formation on the garden paper.
- Rehearsing our Christmas songs and dance ready for the production.
