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Activities to try:

- Go on a shape hunt and look for squares and oblongs (N.B we call rectangles **oblongs**). How many different squares and oblongs can you find? Keep a tally of how many squares you find.
 - Play Simon Says and orally segment (break down the word) e.g Touch your h-ea-d, p-a-t your t-u-m. Take it in turns and ask your child to be 'Simon'.
- Read a story with your child and ask them to retell the story to their favourite teddy bear or character.
