## Our week ahead - What are we going to be learning?

- Counting in 2s and beginning to learn we only count the even numbers.
- Learning the difference between an odd and even number.
- Continuing to add and apply our addition skills to solve problems.
- Making the same number in different ways using different resources such as objects,
   Numicon and even number sentences.
- Learning the nativity story.
- Sequencing pictures from the nativity using time related words such as first, next, after that and finally.
- Writing sentences focusing on finger spaces and letter formation.
- How to write a list to Father Christmas, ready to take to the post box the following week.
- Rehearsing our Christmas songs and dance ready for the production.

#### Work at home...

We have learnt which colours are the primary colours and what happens when we mix them, what new colours do we make? This week we would like you to explore colour mixing at home. Some ideas are mixing red and yellow water (using food colouring) and take a photo for you book, do some painting with primary colours and try to mix it, shaving foam and paint in a zip up food bag (see photo below).
