- Maths Revisiting place value and applying all our number skills to word problems.
- Handwriting Capital and lowercase letters: L,T,J, I, U, Y
- Spelling ed suffix as in past tense where the root word doesn't change, e.g jump > jumped
- Phonics /j/ written as 'g(e)' as in age, 'g(i) as in gist, 'g(y) as in clergy' and /j/ written 'dge' as in dodge.

Summer Term Homework Expectations.

As we move into our last term in year 1 we are starting to prepare the children for year 2. That means we will be starting to increase the homework expectation.

<u>Reading</u> There will be no change with the reading expectation. The children will receive a new, physical book, on a Monday (to be returned on Friday) and a BugClub phonic book will be assigned, online, on a Friday.

<u>Maths</u> MyMaths will be set on a Friday. This will be a game or activity for you to complete within the week.

<u>Spelling</u> We will be setting weekly spellings. This will consist of 5 spellings linked to a phonics sound and 5 high frequency words. These will be set on a Tuesday for a test the following Tuesday. Will be setting the words on Spelling Shed for the children to practise.

Other Children also have access to Purple Mash and Oxford Owl free ebooks, however there is no expectation that the children have to use these - they are just extra resources.

Eye tests were carried out last week. You should have received a letter regarding your child's results. These went home in book bags. If you did not receive a copy then please let us know.
