Trip to Sarehole Mill.

On the 17th, 18th and 19th January, we have arranged a really exciting Year 3 Stone Age trip to Sarehole Mill. This will consolidate the children's learning on the previous topic of 'Early Man' which focuses on the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. As the centre can only hold 30 children at a time, each Year 3 class will be going on a different date:

3P: 17th January

3C: 18th January

3M: 19th January

In accordance with our Charging Policy, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £16 per pupil, to cover costs such as travel, entrance and insurance. Unfortunately, in some cases where there are insufficient contributions, we have to consider cancelling trips or events which we naturally try to avoid. Your contributions go a long way to helping us manage our school funds to ensure maximum value for every child, so thank you in anticipation of your ongoing financial support. Payments should be made via ParentPay.

We will travel by coach to Sarehole Mill and will be spending the day taking part in various Prehistoric activities including: shelter making; exploring Stone Age food; visiting a Bronze Age site; and creating Stone Age cave paintings using authentic materials!

We will be leaving school at 9:30am and aim to be back to school at 3:00pm. Children will be collected from the playground as usual. However, should any complications arise due to traffic, we will inform the school immediately.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag. Please do not send your child with any glass bottles. If your child receives free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by AIP, our school caterers. The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip. As the weather may be cold and we will be based outside, we ask that all children wear wellingtons or other outside footwear and come wrapped up warmly, ideally in a thick or waterproof coat.
