



Year 1 | Our Week Ahead - 03/05/2021

Here is what we are learning about next week:

- English – instructional writing 'how to plant a seed'.
- Maths - grouping numbers, focusing on 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Phonics - /ch/ written as 'tch' as in switch and learning the letters that are consonants and vowels.
- Science - classifying plants, such as roses, sunflowers, dandelions into wild flowers, garden plants or weeds.
- Geography - learning about the country Australia and revising the names of the continents and oceans (You can do this at home by singing the following songs: Five Oceans <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X6BE4VcYngQ> Seven continents <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=K6DSMZ8b3LE>

We have also sent a seed kit home for your child to plant and look after. There is a plant diary available on the website if you would like to observe the plants growth.

Reading books aloud to children stimulates their imagination and expands their understanding of the world. It helps them develop language and listen skills ... If your child is a confident reader you may wish to start reading chapter books with them. We are currently enjoying a Roald Dahl novel as our class book.
