Here is what we are learning about next week:

- English – We are reading an alternative version of Jack and the Beanstalk called, 'Jack and the Jelly Beanstalk', we will then describing what we might find at the top of a Jelly Beanstalk.
- Handwriting - All descender letters: y, p, f, g, j, q
- Phonics - Revising alternative spellings for /ai/ as in 'ai' in paid, 'ay' in pay and 'a_e' in bake. Also alternatives for /igh/ as in 'igh' in light. 'le' in pie and 'i_e' in kite.
- Maths - Halving shapes and numbers using a range of physical resources.
- Science - Classifying types of trees, specifically looking at: Pine, oak, sycamore, birch and horse chestnut.
- Geography - Learning about the similarities and differences between the UK and Australia.

5. Help your child find words he/she knows as you read.
