Here is what we are learning about next week:

- English – Creating a story map to aid the retelling of ‘Sayeeda The Pirate Princess’.
- Handwriting - teen numbers: eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty.
- Phonics - Applying phonics knowledge to a variety of texts.
- Maths - Applying place value knowledge to practical and written problems.
- History - Learning about the explorer Sir Francis Drake.
- Science - Comparing the weathers and how the length of the day changes across the seasons.
