Please can children wear plain jogging bottoms (blue or black) with their Nursery polo-shirt and jumper/cardigan. Children will need a warm coat or waterproofs that you don't mind getting muddy. We ask that a change of socks and trousers is sent in too incase they get wet and muddy during the session. Please can spare clothes be sent in a named plastic bag each week. Children will be given a biscuit at Forest Rangers- please inform a member of Nursery staff if your child has any allergies relating to this.
- Please ensure that your child has a book bag that is sent in on their first day of Nursery each week. We will not be able to send books home for children without book bags.
- Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle that contains only water and not squash. This is needed for each session that your child attends Nursery.
- We politely request that siblings do not touch any of our outdoor equipment at drop off and pick up times. This is to prevent cross-contamination between bubbles
