Important Dates and Messages:

On Tuesday 15th, children will be having their individual photos. We please ask that <u>all</u> children come in their uniform. If your child is in the <u>Conker Class</u>, their photos will be at 9:15. If your child is in the <u>Berry Class</u>, their photos will be at 9:00am if they do a morning/all day session and 12:30pm if they do an afternoon session. <u>If your child does not attend on a Tuesday</u> and you would like their photo taken, we please ask you to bring them to the church doors on site where the photos will be taken in their hall. We ask you to please wait outside so you can then collect your child after their photo has been taken.

Please remember children will now be doing P.E. in their P.E. kits. This is a unbranded tracksuit either black or navy, a white top and trainers. School jumpers can also be worn. Due to COVID, we please ask that you send your child in on their P.E. day in their P.E. kit. They can then wear this all day. If your child is in the Conker class, this will be a Monday and the Berry class will be Tuesday morning. Please note that only children who attend the Berry class on a Tuesday morning will do P.E. and if your child attends a Tuesday afternoon they can attend in usual uniform.

Now that the weather is warmer can you please ensure that your child brings a named sun hat into Nursery each day, we ask that you apply sunscreen before they come into Nursery as staff are not able to do this throughout the day.

Our school policy promotes health eating, Can you please ensure that your child has water in their bottle each day, squash, juice is **not** allowed. Many thanks.
