This week we have been...

- Learning about the concept of the word 'different'.
- Using our crocodile fingers (pincer grip) to pick up very small objects and thread cheerios onto pipe cleaners.
- Focusing on The Gingerbread Man story. We have discussed who the characters in the story are, sequenced the story and made Gingerbread men using gingerbread playdough.
- Learning about how everyone is different and how everyone likes to play with different things in PSHE.
- Drawing chalk circles on the floor and using water and paintbrushes or dusters to make them disappear.

Important Dates and Messages:
