Important information regarding children moving to our Reception:

Weekend Task

This week perhaps you could play hide and seek with a twist? First, choose an object to hide. Then tell your child what you have hidden by saying the sounds in the word. For example, if you hide a pen you could say 'p-e-n' to your child, if you hide a car you could say 'c-ar' to your child etc. If your child is confident at hearing the sounds and blending them together, you could challenge them to choose an object to hide. Are they able to segment the sounds to give you a clue?
