MTC: From now, until after the Multiplication Tables Check, Times Tables Rockstars (TTRS) will be all of the children's weekly homework instead of MyMaths. If they would like to continue with the MyMaths games/activities they may do so. The expected amount of games for the children to play, weekly, is 8 – 10 games. On Tuesday, the children had the chance to log onto the MTC application and complete a 'test run'. All the children were able to familiarise themselves with the layout and the process. The real multiplication check will take place on *Tuesday 22<sup>th</sup> June*. The results will not be available until *Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June*.

**Maths**: Next week, we will be starting to learn about time. As time was not teacher taught last year, due to the school's closure, we will be going back to basics starting with o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to.
