English: We are currently learning about balanced discussion texts. The WAGOLL the children have learnt is called 'Should dragons be kept as pets?'. This week we did some role play! The children were all given a character, their profession and a little background information on their character. The children had to argue the reasons for and against this change using reasons specific to their character. They all got into character and did really well!! We were very impressed!
