Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC): The main purpose of the MTC is to establish whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently and help schools identify where further help may be required. They will have a chance to have a practice test before the real thing to ensure they are fully confident what the set up will be like on the day. There has been a lot of anxiety regarding the MTC but we would like to reassure the children that they will do absolutely brilliantly and not to worry about it at all!

- Multiplication Tables Check: The MTC will take place between Monday 7th June and Friday 25th June and the check will take most pupils no longer than 5 minutes to complete. More information on this will follow.
